

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Biron Water Utility

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. Between 01/01/2017 and 03/31/2017, we did not monitor for **coliform bacteria contaminants from well 3, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.**

What precautions should be taken at this time?

There are no special precautions you need to take at this time. However, it is important to remember that the quality of your drinking water is not known at this time.

What was the cause of the missed monitoring requirements?

A raw water bacteria sample from well #3 for the first quarter of 2017 was inadvertently not drawn and tested for coliform bacteria.

What is being done to correct the problem?

A raw water bacteria sample will be collected and tested for coliform bacteria for the first quarter of 2017.

When will the problem be resolved?

April 11, 2017. Sample was tested and came back negative for coliform bacteria.
